Further discussion lead to need of a decent fair size hospital and we felt that other organizations in Truckee and vacinity get behind the movement and we might get a District formed to build and operate a regular 12 bed hospital.

Result was, each organization had a committee member and I was general chairman. I contacted Did Joseph for a site and he and I AM. Lt. Layon Joseph I picked out the site where building now is.
